

# Tenryu Hamanako Railway

The Tenryu Hamanako Railway, affectionately known as the Tenhama Line, has a history of about 90 years, including its former days as the JNR Futamata Line. It connects 39 stations (67.7 km) in western Shizuoka Prefecture, from Kakegawa Station to Shinjohara Station. 36 structures along the line, including turntables, station buildings, platforms, bridges, and tunnels, have been registered as National Important Cultural Properties and are still in active use. In recent years, it has become the setting for many anime, including Evangelion and Laid-Back Camp.
